AD HOC CITIZENS BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CBAC)

The City is seeking participants interested in serving on Montebello's Ad Hoc Citizens Budget Advisory Committee (CBAC). The City Council has created the CBAC for the purpose of providing advice on the development, implementation, and evaluation of the City budget and ways to reduce the structural budget deficit.

Participation in CBAC is an opportunity not only to advise on the prioritization of how City tax dollars are spent, but to create specific recommendations as to budget cuts and creations of revenue to assist the City in the long-term. Many discussions will involve philosophical and strategic issues which impact the budget. It is the role of CBAC members to create tangible recommendations to the City Council for implementation, take information learned in the meetings back into the community and to bring questions/concerns back for discussion.

It is anticipated that CBAC members will meet once per month at City Hall and meetings may be held more frequently, as needed (dates and times TBD). CBAC members will be appointed by Council for a limited term, with no paid stipend.

Requirements for CBAC selection:

- CBAC resident members must live in Montebello and cannot be currently employed by the City or receive any financial benefit from contracts performed with the City.
- CBAC residents may not currently be serving as a City Commissioner or Committee member.
- CBAC members may not be related to a current City Councilmember.
